If you are breastfeeding and have Ohio Medicaid you may qualify for a high-quality double electric breast pump paid for by Ohio Medicaid

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Are you having difficulty breastfeeding due to ???

- Sore nipples
- Breast engorgement
- Infant having difficulty latching-on or difficulty feeding at breast
- Infant with genetic, neurologic, mechanical or other infant issues
- Premature, late preterm or multiples
- Ill or hospitalized breastfeeding infant or mother
- Mother or infant with special needs
- Concerns related to medications in mother's milk
- Need to supplement for low milk supply or infant's slow weight gain
- Very low milk supply and need to increase your milk production
- Other disorders or complications of lactation
- Need to return to school or work

To Qualify:

- You <u>must</u> have delivered your new baby and be breastfeeding or feeding breastmilk to your baby
- 2. You <u>must</u> be enrolled in: **Ohio Medicaid** <u>or</u>

one of the Ohio Medicaid Managed Care Plans:

- Buckeye Community Health Plan
- CareSource
- Molina Healthcare of Ohio
- Unison Health Plan
- Amerigroup
- You <u>must</u> have a prescription showing <u>your</u> medical need for a breast pump written by one of the following:
- Physician
- Advanced Practice Nurse
- Certified Nurse Midwife
- Physician Assistant

(For further information, HCPs may refer to Ohio Medicaid Code for medical necessity – 5103:3-1-01

Qualifying mothers can expect to have their pumps shipped within 24 hours of registration

To Receive your Pump:

3 . Ask your doctor's office to fax a prescription for an "electric breast pump."

(RX <u>must</u> include <u>mother's</u> <u>name and her medical</u> <u>diagnosis</u>, which shows her medical need for a breast pump)

**The prescription must be written in the <u>mother's</u> name (not the baby's) and should <u>include a</u> <u>medical diagnosis for the mother</u>, i.e. "Breastfeeding Difficulty," "Low Milk Supply," "Sore Nipples," etc.
